Quick facts about Flevoland

- Largest man-made area in the world
- Constructed in 1940 1968
- Currently 434.771 "Flevolanders"
- 6 municipalities: Almere, Dronten, Lelystad, Noordoostpolder, Urk and Zeewolde
- Largest producer of wind energy on land in the Netherlands

Three "golden rules" of wind energy


More energy with less turbines

 Follow natural lines (eg roads and canals) in the landscape


Inhabitants must benefit from our wind energy


Regional plan for wind energy

The development of wind energy






