Horizon Europe is the European Union's flagship research and innovation programme with an ambitious budget of 95.5 billion Europ. One of the key advantages of Horizon Europe is its comprehensive approach, fostering collaborations across various sectors and disciplines. Participation in Horizon Europe offers not only funding, but also facilitates international networking and access to new markets, addressing global challenges such as climate change, green transition and digital transformation.
